The development site has been the subject of an extended noise survey, which has demonstrated that the strip of the site adjacent to the A6 (ie to the west of the site) is subject to high levels of road traffic noise during both daytime and night time periods.

An indicative masterplan has been developed which responds sensitively to the A6. This includes a 40 metre set back between the A6 and the closest proposed dwellings.

The masterplan also shows the dwellings sited closest to the A6 having a relatively contiguous frontage facing the A6, which is intended to provide screening to the remainder of the development site to the east. The masterplan layout is designed to meet all design criteria for noise, and minimize additional mitigation measures.

An assessment of development related traffic noise demonstrates that its impact would be of a negligible magnitude. Similarly, an assessment of construction noise indicates that mitigation measures would be able to reduce its impact to an acceptable level.
